









Endangered reboxing everything

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|  | <p>(1) The 9 scenario trays go in a 3x3 grid. Note that each row has ONE tray that is slightly larger (use for scenarios with more wooden meeples)</p> <p>Cards on the bottom (or the top)</p> |
|  | <p>(2) Place the long narrow gray tray at a long side of the box.</p> <p>This can be used for butterflies or red wolf meeples</p> |
|  | <p>(3) Place the game board above the thin tray. It should match the length of the tray and fit perfectly into the box.</p> <p>The height of the thin tray should match the thickness of the game board.</p> |
|  | <p>(4) The long tray of 5 sets of destruction tiles goes on the outside edge of the box. Fits perfectly with the game board.</p> <p>Note: group the tiles by type. Each of the 5 sections might hold more than one type of tile.</p> |

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|  | <p>(5) The wider long double bin tray fits perfectly next to the destruction tiles.</p> <p>The green influence cubes fit perfectly in one of the bins with the turn marker on top of them on one end.</p> <p>Other bin for Red Wolf/Butterfly</p> |
|  | <p>(6) Six player roles fit into two sets of three (white at bottom of black slid into gray trays). All game cards on top of one gray tray. Other is for Red Wolf/Butterfly cards. Coins - 5 on top of the thin black section, rest on top of the cards in the black trays.</p> <p>Two dice and small tokens in tiny bin</p> |
|  | <p>(7) Shows how the three trays slide together with the white under the black on one side and the gray on the other.</p> <p>Coins - 5 in the thin section and the rest on top of the cards</p> |
|  | <p>(8) Place the six role trays on top of the game board with tiny tray in the center.</p> <p>They are tricky to pick up so be careful.</p> |



(9) Place the thick cardboard 0-5 tracker on top of the destruction tiles



(10) Place the cardboard map tracker on top of the 0-5 numbered tracker.

It should fit exactly between the notches on the trays

(11) Rulebooks go on top

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
